Conditions for the 2014 Masters Meet

1. This Meet, Promoted by **The Guernsey Swimming Club LBG** (aff. to SEASA & HCASA), will be conducted under the ASA Laws & under the technical laws of F.I.N.A and is open to all swimmers, incl professionals. Age as at 31st DEC 2014 except must 18 years by 6/4/2014
2. Ages Groups – with age as at 31st December 2013. All must be 18 years or over by **6th April 2014**.
A - 25/29 yrs B - 30/34 yrs C - 35/39 yrs D - 40/44 yrs E - 45/49 yrs F - 50/54 yrs G - 55/59 yrs
H - 60/64 yrs I - 65/69 yrs J - 70/74 yrs K - 75/79 yrs L - 80/84 yrs M - 85/89 yrs N - 18/24 yrs
3. All swimmers must be registered with the ASA or with FINA and must be members of an affiliated club.
4. A competitor may swim for only one club.
5. **Relay Teams** – team names to be given to the recorder prior to the event. Scratch teams of mixed clubs will not be recognised as the winner.
6. There will be **awards** to the first, second and third in each age group in each individual event and an award to the winning team of each relay event, **providing the team is a genuine club team, which had been entered into the programme**. The awards for the winners, 2nd & 3rd to be collected from the table. There will be individual awards to be presented at the Sunday Lunch for top male and top female swimmers and the top non-Guernsey club will be awarded the John Eyre Trophy, calculated on a FINA points basis.
7. All events will be on the basis of **Heat Declared Winner**. In each event swimmers will be seeded according to their submitted entry times and will compete against those with similar times from the various age groups taking part in the event.
8. **Last minute entries** on the day will be accepted as a time trial, subject to payment of the appropriate fee and subject to there being a spare lane available. No additional heats will be created. No awards or points will be given.
9. **Friday Arrival – Club managers must confirm all swimmers are present & swimming the events entered 45 minutes before the start of the Meet so the heat lists can be prepared with no empty lanes. Should any swimmer subsequently decide NOT to swim an event, please notify the recorders as soon as possible to avoid an empty lane.**
10. Start times and the programme format may be altered at the organisers' discretion.
11. **Results** will be prepared on the Hytech Software computer program and will be posted after each event . Results will also be sent to all e-mail addresses in MS Word format.
12. **Records** – any swimmer attempting to set a New World, European, British, Swiss, German or Spanish Record is asked to give the referee as much notice as possible so that the required number of officials is arranged. **Special awards**, one only for each swimmer, will be presented at the lunch to those setting a new individual World, European or GB record and for Relays for a new World or European Relay Record, but NOT for a British Relay Record.
13. **Warm Up Safely** – please follow the guidance of the warm up marshalls . Directional signs will be in place. Lane 1 and Lane 6 will be sprint lanes at declared time .

**ALL SWIMMERS are responsible for their own safety - WARM UP - NO DIVING EXCEPT IN THE SPRINT
LANES PLEASE BE CAREFUL ESPECIALLY FRIDAY EVENING**
